Contrary to this funding downtrend, we ask members (you!) to get ready to grow! FRIENDS goals in 2010 are simple - double membership and raise \$37,000 for 2011 library programming.

We will take recruiting and fundraising on the road with MINI Book Sales at summer gatherings. While we sell books and memberships, we'll be talking up the Fall MEGA Book Sale, ongoing book sales in the libraries and our Literary Fundraiser: *WiseUp - Chapter 2!! presented by the Nighttown Academy of Poetry and Letters* (see press release insert).
